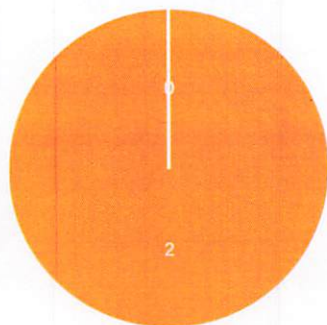

The Board letter says the project is located south of Mesa Rock Road - I think you mean south of Frontage Road..
