





Why should you pay \$5 mil extra to Avaya for redundant desk phones? Here's why.

Nothing wrong with desk phones. Use of cell phones or similar technology in a relatively small area may result in disproportionate concentration of 5G frequency electronic waves which have been shown to sicken sensitive people.

Also, cell phones are easier for people to hack into remotely, so, with all your confidential communications, you might end up paying for enhanced security. Plus people might be even less inclined to trust you with their secrets. Depending on what other software or junk is installed, they can be distracting, and it is easier to do fraud with robocalls or deepfakes on a cell phone.

Maybe you need a provider who offers service where the cost scales down for reduced usage. But it is clear that you need more thought and communication before replacing desk phones.

Virtual fax seems like a better idea but may ultimately have similar confidentiality concerns.
