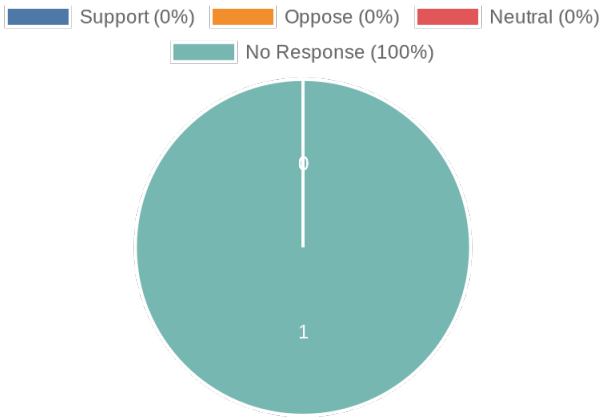

Overall Sentiment

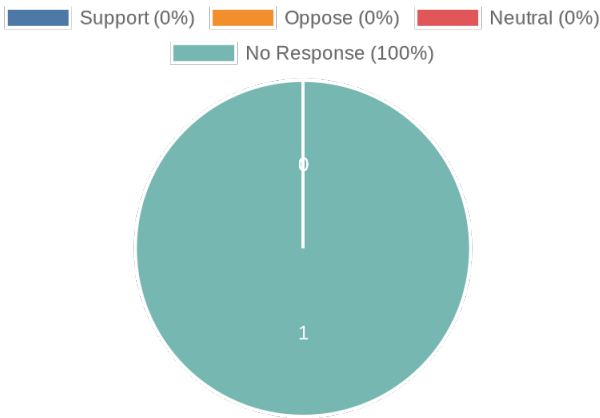

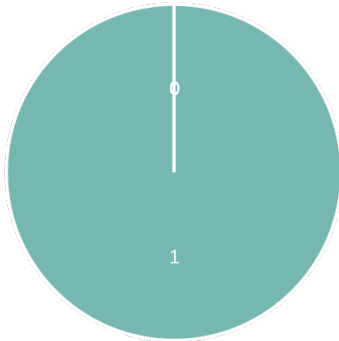
Overall Sentiment
