# Fines Collected For Chemical Testing Involving DUIs

**Current**Practice

Per Penal Code, permits the collection of \$50 to pay for the cost of drug and/or alcohol testing

Requested Authority

Per Penal Code, authorize an additional penalty of \$50, upon defendants convicted of driving under the influence of alcohol and/or drugs, in instances where the defendant has the ability to pay

"Ability to Pay" means the overall capability of the defendant to pay the additional penalty authorized by this subdivision, taking into consideration all of the following:


