






Background

Approved

Expanded Jurisdiction to Investigate deaths:

- Connected to Sheriff/Probation health care providers including staff and contractors
- While in custody
- Within 6 months of compassionate release

Scope of New Jurisdiction



In-Custody Deaths Only

- Ability to investigate Health Care Providers applies to:
 - In-Custody Death

OR

 Death occurring within six months of compassionate release.

Authority

 Arises out of or in connection with the actions of any peace officer, custodial officer, employee or contracted Health Care Provider of the Sheriff's Office or the Probation Department.

Definition

Health Care Provider:


A person, whether employed by the County or as a contractor that provides medical or mental health care or treatment under the direction of the Sheriff's Office or Probation Department, including doctors, nurses, psychiatrists, dentists.


