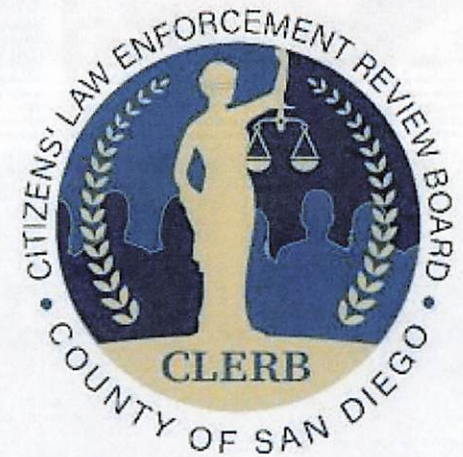

# Background



- Established by voters in 1990

- Reviews include:
  - Citizen Complaints
  - In-Custody Deaths
  - Officer-Involved Shootings
  - Serious Use of Force
  - First Amendment Protest Incidents
- Jurisdiction: Sheriff's Office & Probation Department

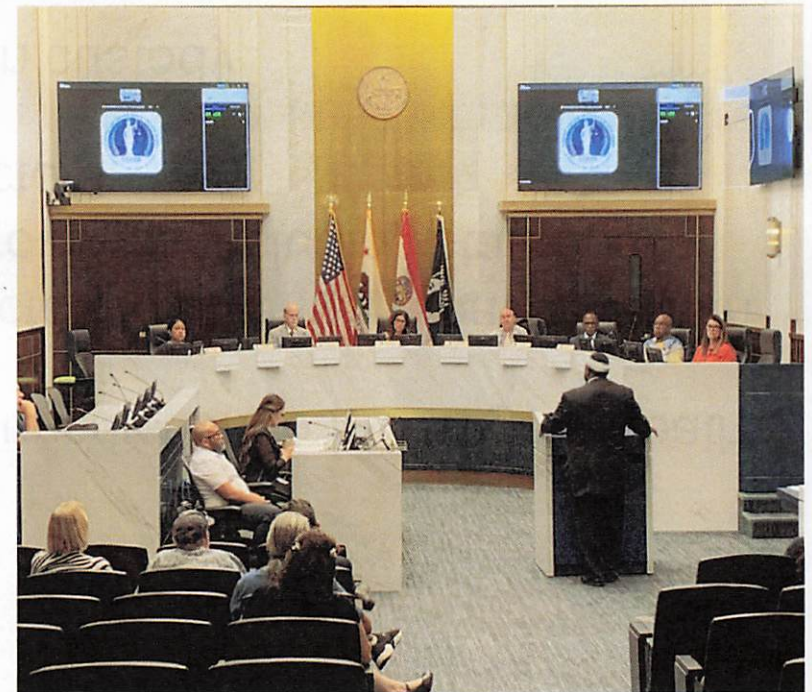






# Board Direction

- Draft amended ordinance to expand CLERB jurisdiction
- Estimate staffing & resource needs
- Review other jurisdictions & investigative models
- Meet-and-confer with labor organizations
- Update CLERB rules & regulations
- Report back with draft ordinance



# CLERB Decision



**Adopted August 7, 2025**

**Rules & Regulations  
Approved**

Expanded Jurisdiction to Investigate deaths:

- Connected to Sheriff/Probation health care providers including staff and contractors
- While in custody
- Within 6 months of compassionate release





# Scope of New Jurisdiction

## In-Custody Deaths Only

- Ability to investigate Health Care Providers applies to:
    - In-Custody Death
- OR
- Death occurring within six months of compassionate release.

## Authority

- Arises out of or in connection with the actions of any peace officer, custodial officer, employee or contracted Health Care Provider of the Sheriff's Office or the Probation Department.

## Definition

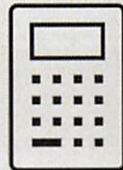
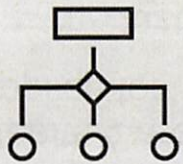
- Health Care Provider:  
A person, whether employed by the County or as a contractor that provides medical or mental health care or treatment under the direction of the Sheriff's Office or Probation Department, including doctors, nurses, psychiatrists, dentists.

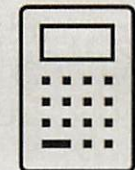
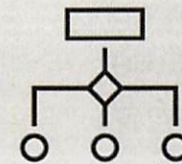

# Summary of Recommendations



1. Approve the introduction of the Ordinance amending the Administrative Code (first reading)
2. If approved today, then on September 30, 2025:
  1. Adopt the Ordinance (second reading)
  2. Consider the approval of the August 7, 2025, amendments to the Citizens Law Enforcement Review Board's rules and regulations
  3. If Board acts on Recommendations 1 & 2, then consider the approval of the request to add 2 FTEs to support CLERB and transfer appropriations of \$417,269 from County Counsel to CLERB to support two full- time positions and consultant services.
