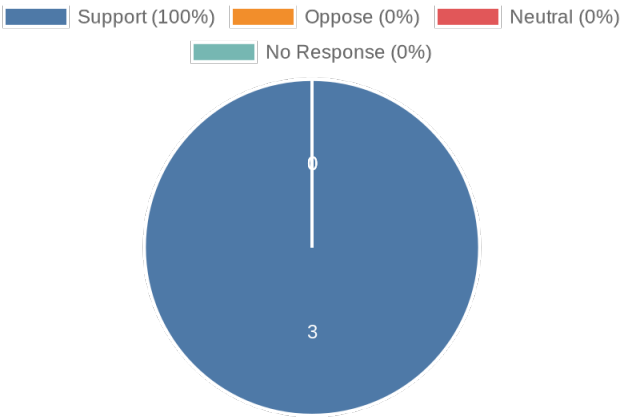

Overall Sentiment



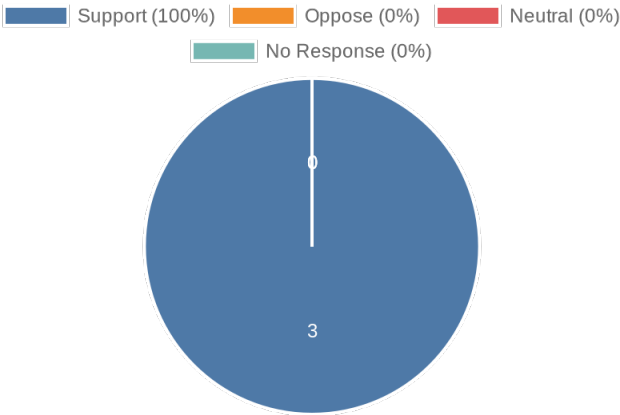

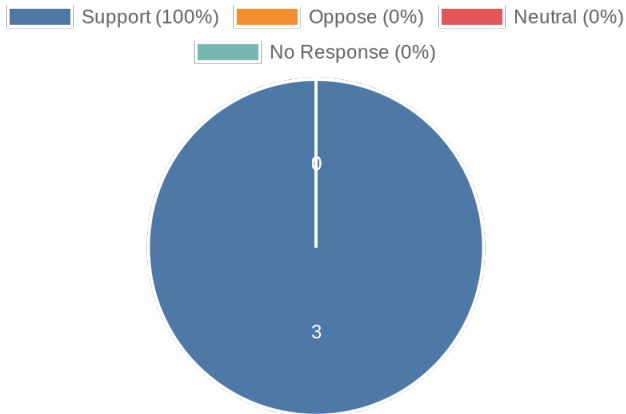
