Waive Board Policy B-29, Fees, Grants, Revenue Contracts - Department Responsibility for Cost Recovery, which requires full-cost recovery of grants for a one-time county match requirement equivalent to 50% of the total estimated overage cost for the program (\$8.8 million) of approximately \$4.4 million associated with the Behavioral Health Continuum Infrastructure Program Launch Ready Grant funding in FY 2022-23 through FY 2026-27. The public benefit of this project far outweighs the B-29 unrecoverable costs because it expands behavioral health services for residents in East Region in need of acute care.
