



### Overall Sentiment



Dear Chair Lawson-Remer and Board Members, This is in reference to a Board Letter of application for CDBG-DR funding on item 5. of the Agenda. The Board Letter proposes a prioritized list of infrastructure, planning, and mitigation projects focused on flood control, stormwater management, erosion repair, drainage studies, and water quality improvements. We understand that projects are listed in the order/rank of priority identified by State criteria and funding is limited.
