BOARD POLICY STATEMENTS:

A-87 - Competitive Procurement.

Item or Service and Time Period: The services to be procured are program evaluation services from October 18, 2022 to June 1, 2026. The Final Local Evaluation Report is due to the funding agency by June 1, 2026.

Benefit to the County of San Diego: The proposed services will provide process and outcome evaluations of regional efforts designed to improve community safety and improve health, including behavioral health, outcomes for adults involved in the justice system.

Justification: As discussed in the Background section above, the Criminal Justice Research Division (CJRD) of SANDAG is recommended for single source approval for reasons that involve efficiency and program continuity; CJRD is also the only research organization serving as the regional criminal justice clearinghouse with access to the Automated Regional Justice Information System (ARJIS) and is also the only agency currently approved by regional criminal justice agencies and by the Health and Human Services Agency to access the MultiAgency Interface System containing criminal justice and behavioral health data.

Determination of Fair and Reasonable Price: The Director, Department of Purchasing and Contracting will enter into negotiations with SANDAG to determine a fair and reasonable price for the services related to the process and outcome evaluation of the Proposition 47 Grant Program.

MANDATORY COMPLIANCE:

Government Code Section 29130(b). The proposed actions establish appropriations of \$658,000 in the Public Safety Group Executive Office for program administration and evaluation services, and \$809,156 in the Health and Human Services Agency for program administration and Community Care Coordination, requiring four votes.
