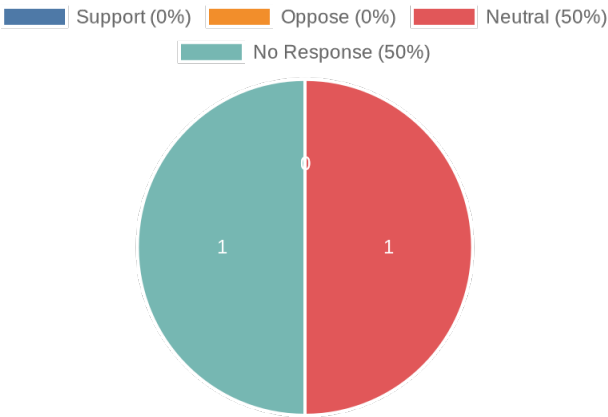

Overall Sentiment

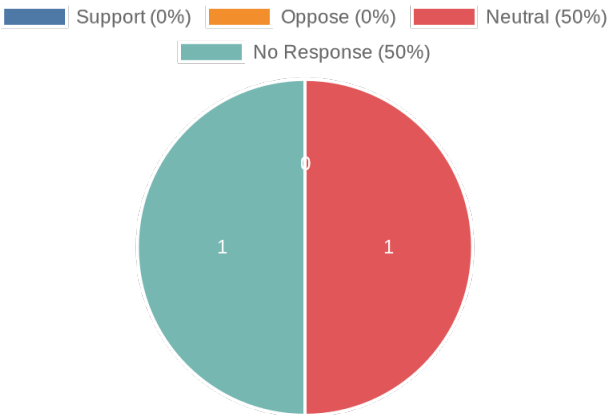

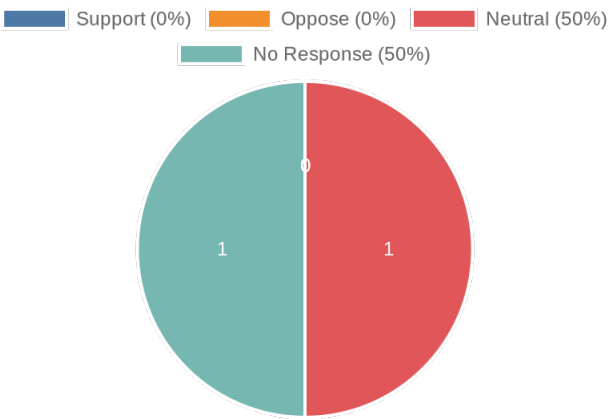
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Overall Sentiment

Currently, small domestic violence providers are structurally locked out of sustainable CalAIM funding due to high administrative and technology barriers. This forced reliance on volatile grants leads to high clinician turnover—a systemic funding issue that disrupts long-term trauma recovery for survivors. I urge the Board to direct HHSA to pilot a Domestic Violence Management Services Organization (MSO) to act as a "shared back-office." This model would centralize complex billing and data tasks, allowing shelters to focus on social and clinical care. By using state incentive funds to bridge the technology gap, the County can shift the financial burden from the General Fund to recurring state Medi-Cal reimbursements. This is a crucial step to modernize our safety net and stabilize our trauma-informed workforce through sustainable funding.
