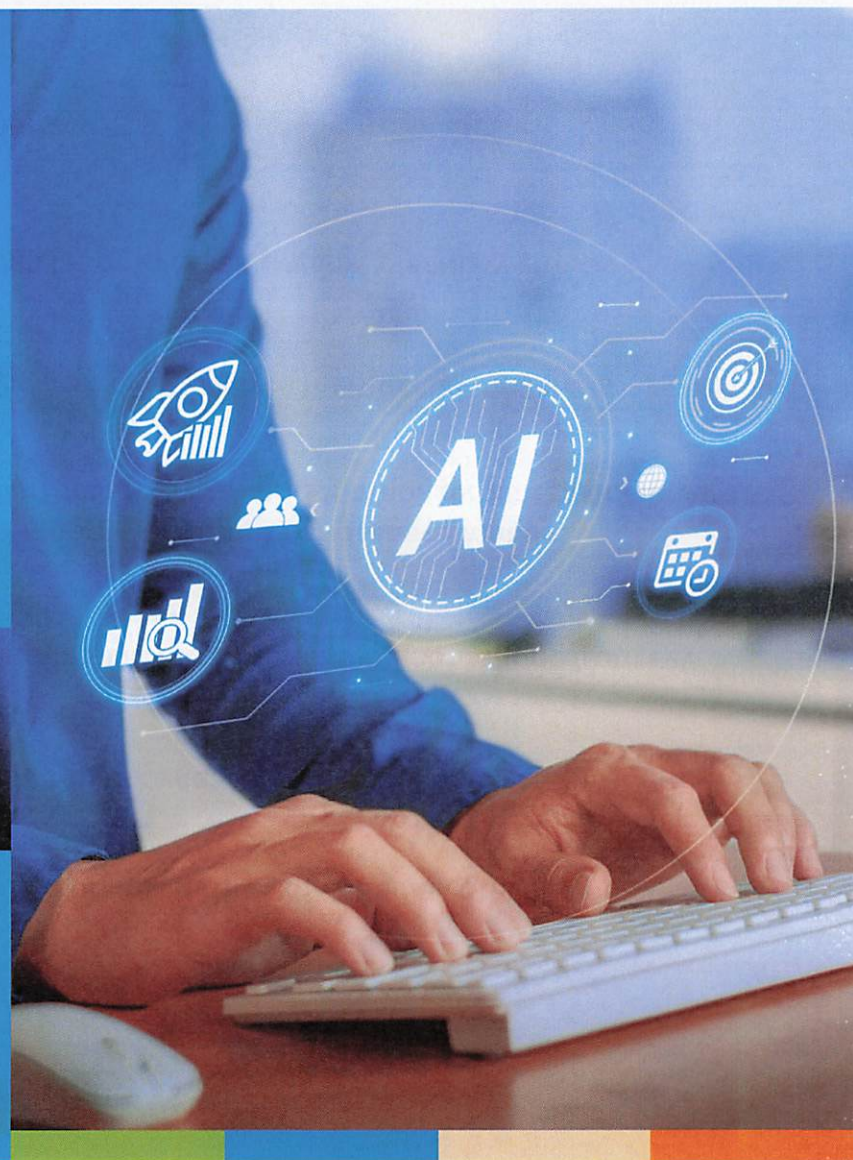

BACKGROUND



June 4, 2024 (13)

County Board of Supervisors established an ad-hoc subcommittee for Artificial Intelligence (AI) and Information Technology (IT) infrastructure.

October 16, 2024

The first subcommittee meeting focused on foundation knowledge of AI and presentations from subject matter experts.

January 15, 2025

Second subcommittee meeting focused on the role of AI in the workforce presentations from key organizations.

February 27, 2025

CAO Memo titled "Research, Best Practices, and Recommendations on Transformative Technologies and Artificial Intelligence" to establish governance, vendor management policies, AI incident response plan, and workforce training.

April 8, 2025 (18)

The CAO was directed to develop an AI governance framework to use responsible AI across County departments.

**April 10 to
August 1, 2025**

Met with ERGs, community groups, worked through labor to reach unions, disability groups and other partners.

August 26, 2025

Report back to the Board on AI Policy and Governance.



OVERVIEW

The County focused on three areas to establish the responsible and safe use of Artificial Intelligence (AI):

- AI Bill of Rights
- Board of Supervisors AI Policy
- AI Governance Framework

AI BILL OF RIGHTS



Key elements:

1. Safe and effective systems
2. Discrimination protections
3. Data privacy
4. Notice and explanation
5. Human alternatives considerations and fallback



1. Adhere to local, state and federal laws
2. Protect confidentiality, integrity and availability of information
3. Provide transparency, equity, utility and privacy
4. Provide risk management
5. Explain prohibited use
