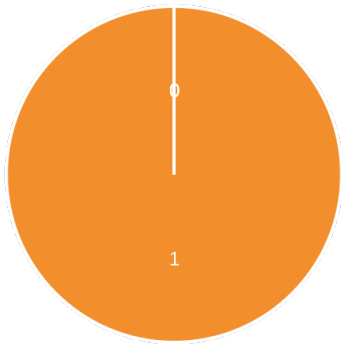

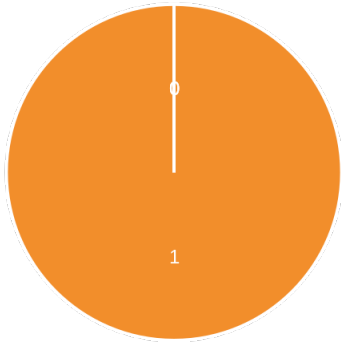

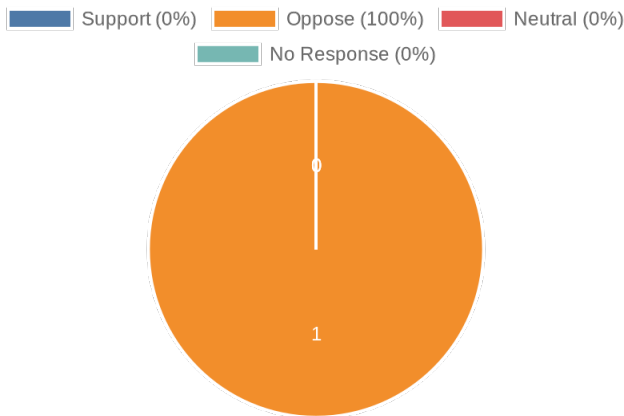

SR67 improvements were promised in 2004 and are still not done. The for all County SR-67 Highland Valley Road to Dye Road project would enhance safety for ALL, increase evacuation capacity for wildfires, and improve traffic flow along a 16-mile stretch of SR-67 from Lakeside to Ramona. Proposed upgrades include widening the highway to four lanes, adding active transportation options, and improving emergency access. It is badly needed and I oppose reallocating money from it.

I also oppose inclusion of the Rancho Santa Fe Roundabouts in San Dieguito in the 2027 Transnet Local Street Improvement Program. Roundabouts in fact hamper emergency response and evacuation.
