

SUMMARY OF PROPOSED ORDINANCE

Notice is Hereby Given that the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Diego will consider for adoption: ORDINANCE AMENDING THE SAN DIEGO COUNTY CODE OF ADMINISTRATIVE ORDINANCES REGARDING LITIGATION AUTHORIZATION FOR COUNTY COUNSEL. This ordinance will give Couty Counsel authority to initiate certain consumer protection lawsuits. Said proposed ordinance will be presented to the Board of Supervisors for the first reading on June 25, 2026 at which time public testimony will be received.
