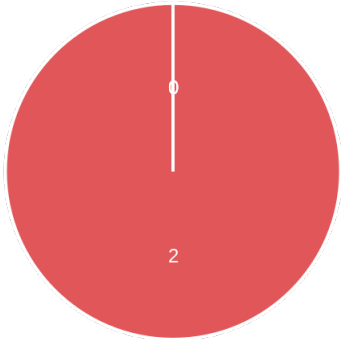
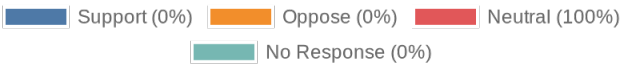

Overall Sentiment

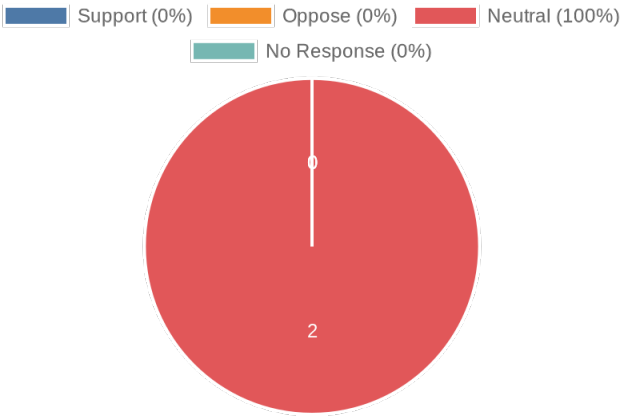

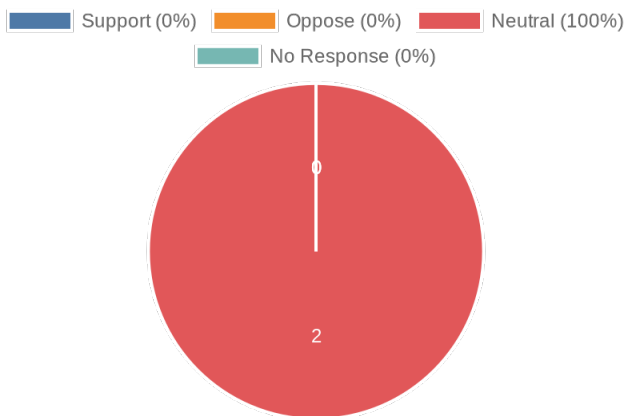
