




### Overall Sentiment

One reason to avoid going sole source here is that different lawyers are probably better adapted to identify an appropriate provider for their individual clients.

The Board letter says that “advocates would assist with obtaining mental health and substance abuse treatment, assessing eligibility and enrolling in public benefits, obtaining employment, and accessing emergency housing resources.” But there are other problems – like Cell Phone or Computer addiction or just plain social incompatibility. The board letter does not address these.

This sort of counseling is best left to HHSA, the housing people, or Behavioral Health, not a sole source provider of duplicate services.
