Big picture – parts of this sound good, but overall, it sounds like a giveaway of our taxpayer dollars to defend people making twice the average median income or more not needing our financial support. And it sounds like the CEO would be asked to explore almost anything – targeted updates to a County-created legal defense fund, community needs, investigate funding opportunities.

Then the Board letter says that 66% of its clients whose cases reached a decision got judicial relief, without saying what it was, and no documents are attached.

So we don't know whether this is really worth it, but that people of basically regular income get to use our taxpayer dollars for it.
