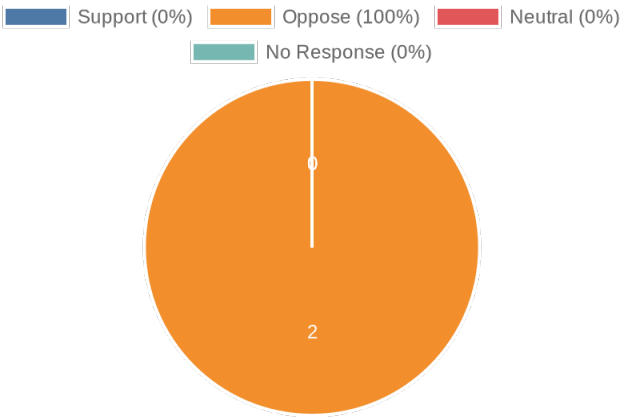

Overall Sentiment

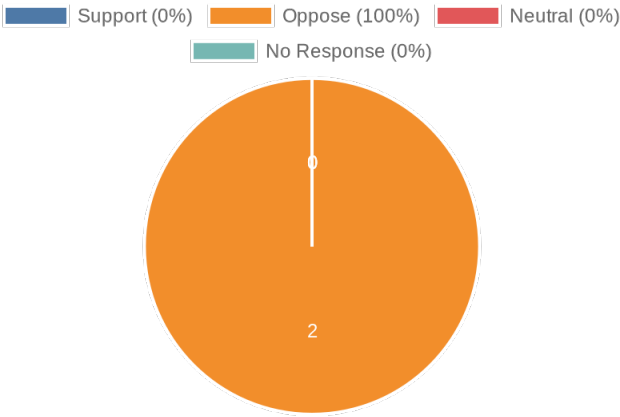

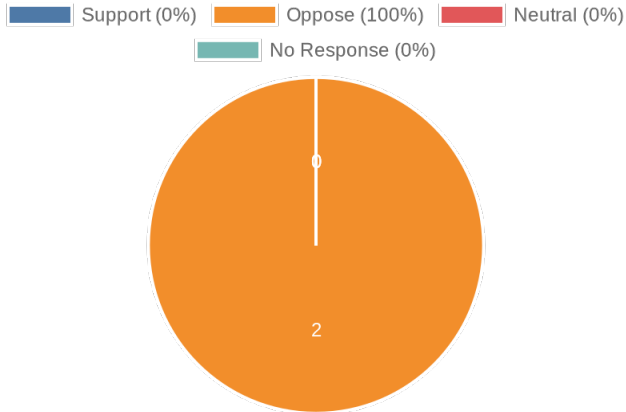

However, since there is an existing Herald Christian Health Center at 7808 Claremont Mesa Blvd. The attachment 4 loan application says it is for the building rather than new land or construction, but \$4.5 million seems expensive for renovation.

And of course there were no public comments at the hearing since the notice was published on the Cal Enterprise Development Authority Website, not what would normally be considered publicly.

Sounds like a good loan, but until we know what exactly it will be used for, it should be rejected.
