

SUMMARY OF PROPOSED ORDINANCE

Notice is Hereby Given that the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Diego will consider for adoption: AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ARTICLE XX OF THE SAN DIEGO COUNTY ADMINISTRATIVE ORDINANCE CODE, RELATING TO SAN DIEGO COUNTY FIRE, SAN DIEGO COUNTY EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES, AND COUNTY SERVICE AREA 17 CHARGES AND FEES. This ordinance will amend 23 fees and 14 rates and add 23 rates. Said proposed ordinance will be presented to the Board of Supervisors for the first reading on May 5, 2026, at which time the Board will be asked to approve the introduction of the Ordinance (first reading) and, if approved, then on May 19, 2026, the Board will consider and adopt the Ordinance (second reading). If the proposed ordinance is altered on May 19, 2026, then on that date a subsequent meeting date will be selected for the ordinance's adoption.

The Board meets at 9:00 a.m., in Room 310, County Administration Center, 1600 Pacific Highway, San Diego, California.


