RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE SAN DIEGO COUNTY
FLOOD CONTROL DISTRICT ACTING AS THE GOVERNING BODY OF
STORMWATER MAINTENANCE ZONES 3-4978-1 BLACKWOLF, 4-4249-3
LAKE RANCHO VIEJO, AND 3-5142-1, PONDEROSA, ADOPTING
ASSESSMENTS AND CONFIRMING REPORTS RE: LEVIES TO BE
COLLECTED ON THE TAX ROLL FOR FISCAL YEAR 2024-25

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 17.5 of the San Diego County Flood Control District Act ("Act") (West's Water Code App. 105.1 et seq.) and applicable District ordinances the Board has determined that levies for operating and maintaining stormwater best management practice improvements as listed above for Fiscal Year 2024-25 shall appear as a separate item on the tax bill and shall be collected at the same time and in the same manner as ordinary County ad valorem property taxes are collected; and

WHEREAS, the Director, Department of Public Works, has prepared written reports describing each parcel of real property receiving particular services computed in conformity with the procedures set forth in, and the charges prescribed by, the applicable ordinances and resolutions of the Stormwater Maintenance Zones; and

WHEREAS, such reports were prepared and available in the Office of Private Road and Landscape Maintenance and Notice of Hearing thereon given as required by law; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to such notice, on July 17, 2024, a hearing was held on said reports; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of the San Diego County Flood Control District has heard and considered all objections and protest to said reports, and to the assessments set forth therein.

NOW THEREFORE IT IS RESOLVED, DETERMINED AND ORDERED AS
FOLLOWS:

1. All objections and protests to said reports have been heard and considered and are overruled.
2. Each and every levy set forth in said reports is adopted.
3. Said reports are hereby confirmed.
4. Copies of said reports as confirmed by the Board shall be immediately transmitted to the Auditor and Controller in order that the assessments may be collected on the tax roll as provided by the San Diego County Flood Control Act (Act) Section 17.5 and applicable District ordinances.
