A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF SAN DIEGO RELATING TO THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE, OFFICE ON VIOLENCE AGAINST WOMEN FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2025 ENHANCED TRAINING AND SERVICES TO END ABUSE IN LATER LIFE GRANT PROGRAM

WHEREAS the San Diego County District Attorney desires to continue the End Abuse in Later Life Program to be funded in part from funds made available through 34 U.S.C. § 12421.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the San Diego County District Attorney, and/or her designees, are authorized to serve in the role of Application Submitter, Authorized Representative and Entity Administrator for the purpose of applying for and accepting a federal grant on behalf of the County of San Diego as stated in Board Letter REQUEST TO APPLY FOR AND ACCEPT GRANT FUNDS AND APPROVAL OF A SINGLE SOURCE PROCUREMENT FOR THE ENHANCED TRAINING AND SERVICES TO END ABUSE IN LATER LIFE PROGRAM dated September 9, 2025, and administering the Enhanced Training and Services to End Abuse in Later Life Program on behalf of the County of San Diego for the period of October 1, 2025 through September 30, 2028, and authorize the District Attorney to apply for and accept U.S. Department of Justice funding for this program and affiliated elder abuse grants in subsequent years, provided there are no material changes to the grant terms or funding levels.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chief Administrative Officer or her designees, or the District Attorney or her designees, as necessary, are authorized to sign and approve on behalf of the County of San Diego Board of Supervisors all grant award documents, including any extensions and amendments thereof, that do not materially impact or alter either the grant program or funding level.

IT IS AGREED that the County of San Diego shall be subject to any terms and conditions of the grant award.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the grant funds received hereunder shall not be used to supplant expenditures controlled by this body.
