AN ORDINANCE CALLING A SPECIAL ELECTION TO BE CONSOLIDATED WITH THE STATEWIDE GENERAL ELECTION ON NOVEMBER 3, 2026 FOR THE PURPOSE OF SUBMITTING TO THE VOTERS AMENDMENTS TO THE CHARTER OF THE COUNTY OF SAN DIEGO ENTITLED, "A TRANSPARENT, ACCOUNTABLE, MODERN COUNTY GOVERNMENT"

This ordinance will order a special election to be consolidated with the General Election for proposed amendments to the County Charter that will establish an Independent Ethics Commission, Independent Budget Analyst, Independent Program Auditor, confirmation of certain senior County leaders, and optional Board of Supervisors appointment of the Public Defender; increase term limits from two to three terms for Board of Supervisors members; require public disclosure of spending and performance data; clarify non-interference provisions; and update terminology and structure. Said proposed ordinance will be presented to the Board of Supervisors for adoption on June 25, 2026, at which time public testimony will be received.

The Board meets at 9 a.m., in Room 310, County Administration Center, 1600 Pacific Highway, San Diego, California.
