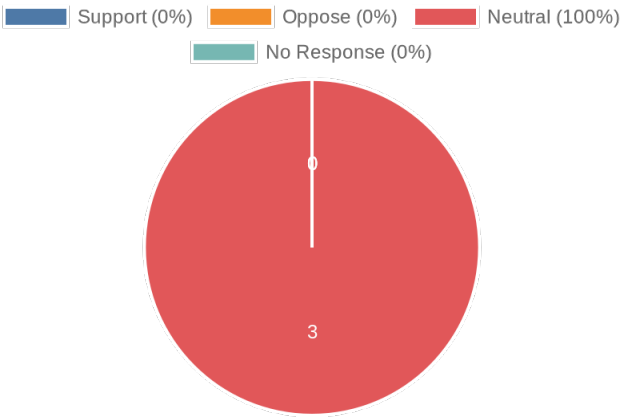

Overall Sentiment



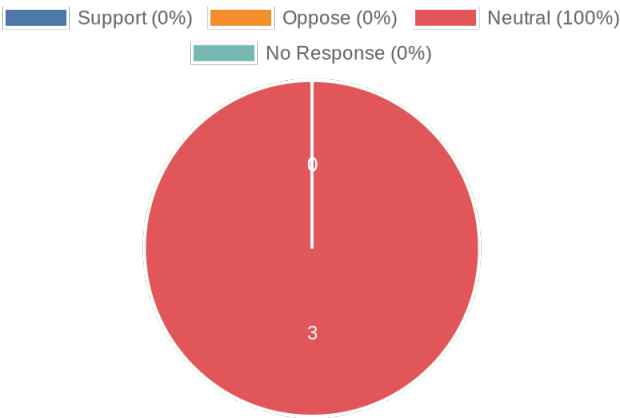

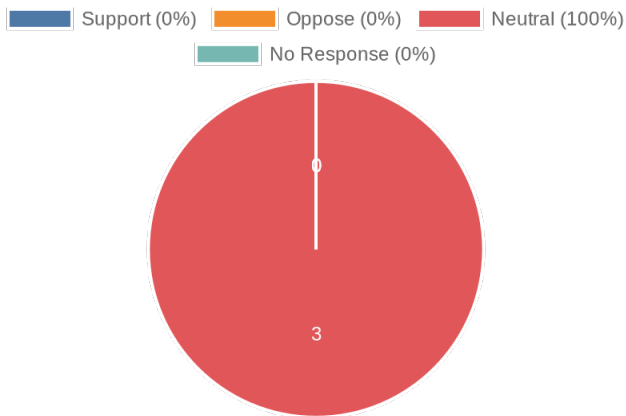
