Overview





Felony Incompetent to Stand Trial (IST)


- Charged with felony crimes, but due to mental illness unable to understand the charges against them or assist their counsel in their defense
- Courts assess IST determination with clinical evaluation from County Forensic Evaluation Unit
- Once deemed IST, the Court will order defendant to the California Department of State Hospitals (DSH) for treatment
- Goal of treatment is to restore competency to return to court

Individuals Declared Incompetent to Stand Trial in San Diego County (FY 2017-18 to FY 2024-25)





IST Diversion and Community-Based Restoration Infrastructure Project Grant Round 1





- One-time grant funding from DSH
- Aims to increase state capacity of residential treatment homes and facilities for people who are:
 - Charged with a felony
 - Deemed IST, and
 - Eligible for diversion or community-based services
- Anticipated to create approximately 5,000 new beds statewide



Plan to Utilize Grant Funding





- County of San Diego received preliminary award of up to \$21,375,000
- Counties must expend award funds by June 30, 2028
- Grant funds will be used toward San Diego County Psychiatric Hospital renovation cost to convert a portion of existing beds to specialized long-term care beds for patients deemed IST
