RESOLUTION NO. 2025-01

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE RAMONA CEMETERY DISTRICT REQUESTING THE SAN DIEGO BOARD OF SUPERVISORS TO INCREASE THE NUMBER OF TRUSTEES BY TWO FROM THREE TO FIVE

WHEREAS, it is the policy of the Ramona Cemetery District (the "District") Board of Trustees (the "Board") to: represent the District such that (i) District operational needs are met, (ii) the services are provided to the community in a respectful manner; and (iii) the County, LAFCo, District employees, and the community at large have full faith and trust in the ability of the Board to help the District grow; and

WHEREAS, currently the Board consists of three Trustees, which is uncommon for a California Public Cemetery District of this size, and the Board has become concerned with its ongoing responsibilities in light of the smaller size of the Board; and

WHEREAS, the Board believes that increasing the size of the Board from three to five Trustees would inherently and immediately increase the effectiveness of the Board by allowing for ad hoc committees and better delegation of duties in light of the work required; and

WHEREAS, California Health and Safety Code § 9025 allows for the District to petition the San Diego County Board of Supervisors to increase the number of members of the Board of Trustees, and thus, the purpose and intent of this Resolution is to formally request that the San Diego County Board of Supervisors increase the District's Board of Trustees by two (2) members taking the total from three to five.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDERED AS FOLLOWS:

 Pursuant to California Health and Safety Code § 9025(a), the Ramona Cemetery District via the Board of Trustees hereby officially request the San Diego Board of Supervisors increase the number of members of the Board of Trustees by two (2) members taking the total from three to five, and appoint individuals to those additional seats. Pursuant to 9025(b) "Within 60 days of receiving a resolution adopted pursuant to subdivision (a), the board of supervisors shall consider the resolution at a public hearing."
- 3. Board Trustee Benefits
 of any kind or paid for attending any Board meeting. Any reimbursements shall be for training if Board approved.
- 4. <u>Delegation of Duties</u> The Board hereby delegates to the District's general counsel the duties and authorities to effectuate this Resolution as needed and directs the general counsel to work with the County to ensure that this request is completed as quickly and efficiently as possible.
- 5. <u>Effective Date</u> The President of the Board shall sign this Resolution and another Board member shall attest thereto, and this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon adoption.
