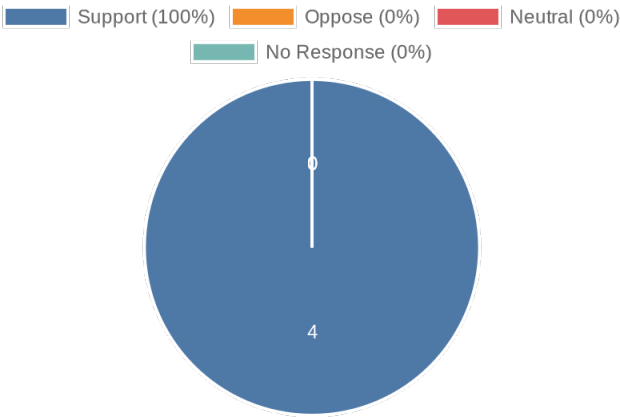

Overall Sentiment

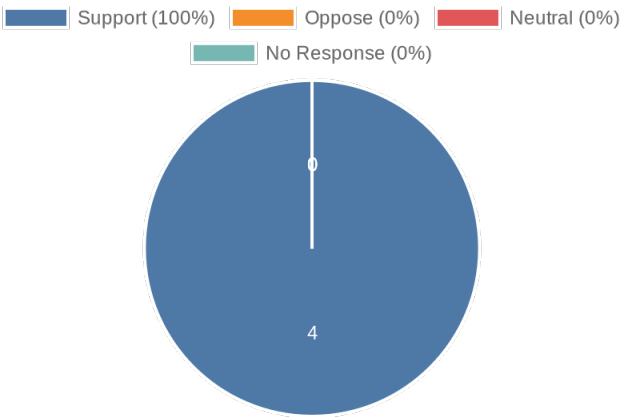

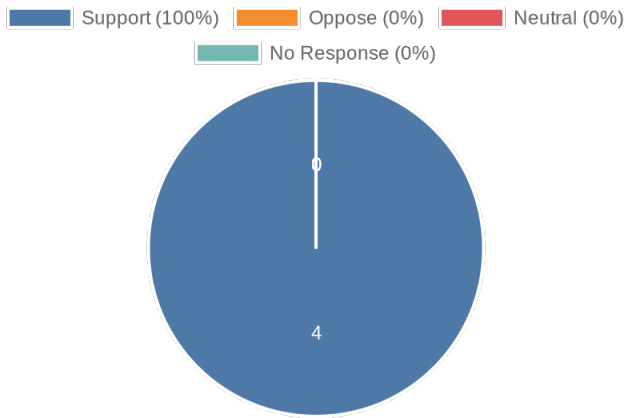

I am a TAY service provider and strongly support this project. Two concerns:

1. Age limits conflict with permanent supportive housing definition. Residents should not face displacement at 26 if this is true PSH. Please clarify the tenancy policy including length of stay.
2. Foster-youth-only eligibility risks vacancies. Please request current occupancy and waitlist data from CFWBD for THP+, TYH, and THPP-NMD before proceeding. These programs often have open availability for the same population. Expanding eligibility to all homeless TAY ages 18–25 would maximize occupancy without abandoning foster youth as a priority.
