**RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF SAN DIEGO  
DECLARING CANDIDATES ELECTED TO COUNTY CENTRAL COMMITTEES  
RELATED TO THE MARCH 5, 2024 PRESIDENTIAL PRIMARY ELECTION.**

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of Part 5 (commencing with Section 7770, et. seq.) of Division 7 of the California Elections Code, all recognized parties elect members to their County Central Committees at the presidential primary election; and

WHEREAS, Elections Code Sections 7772.1 direct that candidate names not be printed on the ballot when the number of qualified nominees for a County Central Committee is fewer than, or equal to, the number of positions to be elected, and that, instead, in lieu of an election, the Board of Supervisors declares elected the candidates who have been nominated; and

WHEREAS, there was an insufficient number of qualified nominees for the San Diego Peace and Freedom County Central Committee 2<sup>nd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> Supervisorial Districts for the March 5, 2024 Presidential Primary Election.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS RESOLVED AND ORDERED that Joseph Moore, Forest Smith, and Sierra Tillman, qualified nominees for the Peace and Freedom Party County Central Committee from the 2<sup>nd</sup> Supervisorial District, are declared elected to said County Central Committee; and

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED AND ORDERED that Victoria Barron, Lyle Batalona, Jose Cortes, Charlie Eichel, Justine Mann, David Petr, and Emily Von Gerichten, qualified nominees for the Peace and Freedom Party County Central Committee from the 4<sup>th</sup> Supervisorial District, are declared elected to said County Central Committee.

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED AND ORDERED that Zachary Bowersock, Jeremiah Bursian, Daniel Colmenarez, Eric McGill, Christianne McCormick, and Clay Scheller, qualified nominees for the Peace and Freedom Party County Central Committee from the 5<sup>th</sup> Supervisorial District, are declared elected to said County Central Committee.
