IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED that the Sheriff, Undersheriff, San Diego County Sheriff's Office; Assistant Sheriff, Law Enforcement Services Bureau; Executive Director, Management Service Bureau; Commander, Law Enforcement Services Bureau; Chief Finance Officer, Contracts and Grants Manager, Management Services Bureau; Crime Lab Captain and Crime Lab Director are authorized to perform for and on behalf of the named applicant, any actions necessary, including the execution of agreements with other government and non-government agencies, annual extensions, and/or amendments for the purpose of grant program management and solicitation of federal financial assistance provided by the U. S. Department of Justice and sub-granted through the California Governor's Office of Emergency Services (Cal OES).
