Good Afternoon, Supervisors,

Where are the amendments for recommendation 1 part 2? This is a public proceeding. We should know what the specific changes are. Using language like 'such as...' or descriptions rather than specifics are not acceptable.

As for the ordinances in part 4:

Section 66.1 allows the Sheriff to get money or assets seized by Fed agencies (ICE, BPS, FBI, etc.) and then says that is essentially a bribe to ensure co-operation with them. It specifies that "The Program's purpose shall be to provide an added incentive to the Sheriff's Office to join with Federal, State and other local law enforcement agencies to stem the rising tide of crime..." And then, the audit is yearly, so we might not find out about improper use for a year or more. That is, they could arrest someone and sell off his heirlooms almost with impunity.

Section 66.4 has the same odious language.

These sections need to be rewritten if not cancelled.

Closing down the courthouse construction fund completely is a bad idea. The inside is shabby. There will always be a need.
