Policy			
It is the policy of the Board of Supervisors that:			
1. The role of McClellan-Palomar Airport shall be to provide air transport residents of North San Diego County and to facilitate general aviation supp while minimizing noise impacts on surrounding areas and communities.			
2. Scheduled commuter airline operations are limited to aircraft having 7 meet the approach speed and wingspan categories for McClellan-Palon accordance with FAA regulations. Commuter airline aircraft shall meet the or IV noise criteria.	nar Airport in		
3. The County will take a proactive role working with local agencies, th County Regional Airport Authority, and the FAA to protect the airspac airport from encroachment and to promote compatible off airport land deve	e around the

4. The County will operate the airport in accordance with any adopted FAA Part 150 Noise Compatibility Plan recommendations and in full compliance with any State or Federal mandated noise standards relating to the operation of a public airport. The program will recognize the Noise Element of the City of Carlsbad's General Plan and implement mitigation measures consistent with State, Federal and FAA Grant Assurance

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Agreements to minimize noise impacts.

The County will monitor aircraft noise and verify the Community N Level (CNEL) noise contours within the airport influence area as described Airport Land Use Compatibility Plan as well as monitor pilot compliance Airport's Voluntary Noise Abatement Program.
