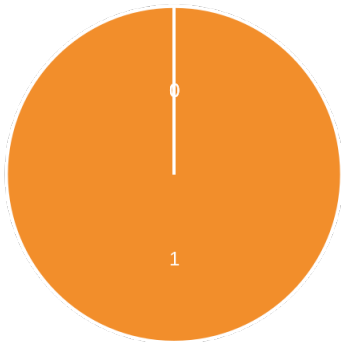

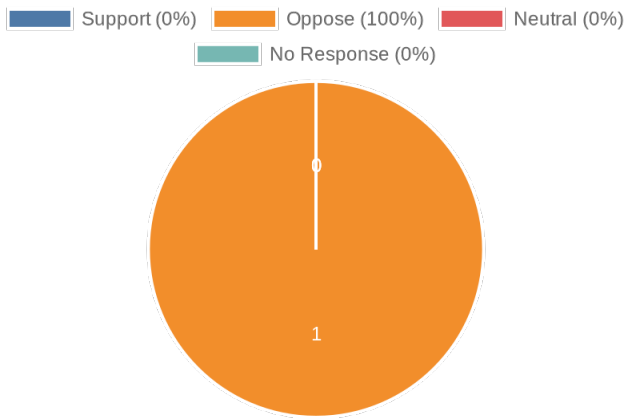

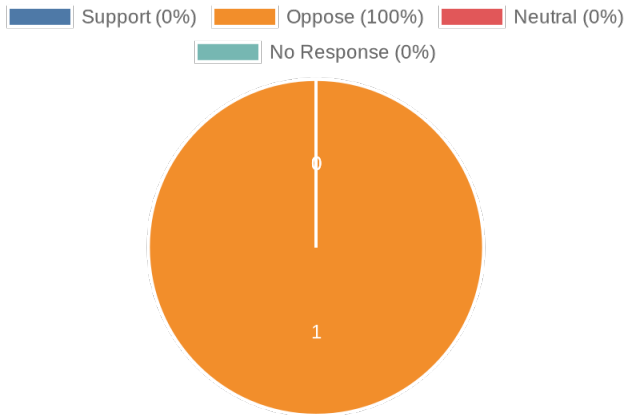

The fee schedule has huge increases to building fees just as housing prices are coming down. Is this to make up for lower prices? Or does County Fire want to discourage homebuilding or improvement? But building permit increase of 42 or 52% for non-commercial buildings but a decrease of 30% for commercial buildings is ridiculous. 100% increase for grading plan review – who doesn't have a grading plan in this hilly County?

This favors business and discourages housing. Will result in rent increases too.

Ambulance fees are more reasonable, but the 20% increase in base hospital designation to \$73 thou seems to discourage new base hospitals in East County, And I hope the Ambulance Permit increase to \$12 thou doesn't mean more care providers using old, outdated ambulances.

The Fire Mitigation Program (agenda #FP02) can do a 3.6% increase, so a 40 to 100% increase is outrageous.

You need to rethink what these fees will do to the County.
