Request to Amend Item #14 – Attachment A 2026-31 CINA

We are writing regarding Item #14, Attachment A 2026-31 CINA, Page 2, Line Item #3, concerning the Butterfield Ranch/Star Valley Development.

We respectfully request that the following sentence be removed:  
“Both sites are considered for an Intergenerational Center.”

We are sincerely appreciative of the proposed \$3 million allocation for our future parks and would very much like to support this funding request. However, we are concerned that the current wording could be interpreted to suggest that Butterfield Ranch and Star Valley are the only potential locations under consideration for the Intergenerational Center (IGC).

Our community values its parkland deeply and believes that Valley Center should have a meaningful voice in determining the most appropriate location for the IGC. It is important to us that the IGC be placed at the location that will best serve the long-term needs of our residents. We are just now beginning the outreach efforts to give voice to the community and its needs.

We respectfully ask that you consider revising the language so that we may confidently support this important funding request while ensuring thoughtful placement of the IGC.
