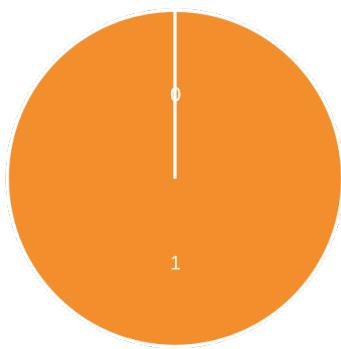



This creates a flexpool. Sounds cool, doesn't it. It isn't. There is no reason for it being sole-source. The flexpool simply is a mechanism to coordinate rental assistance payments where more than one source of funding, such as federal, State, and private funding, are used together. It Sounds like a giant interactive database, something many companies could do. And the chosen contractor, Brilliant Corners, still needs to be Medi-Cal certified. The justification does not really say what specifically qualifies it to be sole-source - just that Bright Pool has been with the task force on homelessness since 2020.

Then, the Board letter says BHS recommends the initial focus be on housing individuals enrolled in Assertive Community Treatment (ACT) services.

Sounds like it has the contractor and the people served already planned. No equity. Only a sort of discrimination.
