Dear Board of Supervisor,

I respectfully ask the Board to consider how this proposal may be perceived by the public. The Supervisors who would directly benefit from extending term limits are also the ones advancing this measure.

From the public's perspective, three sitting Supervisors voted to place a measure on the ballot that could allow them to remain in office longer. They are also in the position to determine how the measure is presented to voters. While the final decision rests with the voters, this creates the appearance of a conflict of interest and raises understandable concerns about public trust.

I believe County government functions best when its leaders focus on the issues that matter most to residents—addressing the cost of living, strengthening public safety, maintaining our roads and infrastructure, protecting our water resources, and improving the quality of life in our neighborhoods.
