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Supervisors of San Diego County,

Please consider that while cannabis is an agricultural crop, unlike wine grapes and other alcoholic products, there is no legal threshold on how high is too high to be driving/behind the wheel to establish a DUI/DWI.

However, like alcoholic products the consumption of cannabis products does impair one's ability to think, react and reason, operate machinery etc.

Living in a rural community with Hwy 67 and Hwy 78 being some of the most dangerous roads already, how likely are accidents and fatalities to increase with zero legal thresholds for cannabis consumption?

California and other states have established thresholds and testing procedures related to alcohol consumption and law enforcement agencies are able to enforce those standards but not with the consumption of cannabis.

What do law enforcement agencies say about allowing more availability of cannabis? How do they feel about "consumption lounges"? I'd like to hear more from them before you make any sort of decision about our rural communities in this regard.

Also, there has been much more crime centered around cannabis facilities and farms and pretty much zero crime at vineyards and boutique tasting rooms. You just can't compare the two. Cannabis farms are ripped off and facilities are robbed on a consistent basis. Even with armed guards and security systems in place, robberies are common. Are you willing to be responsible for increased crime and violence in your communities?

We already do not have enough law enforcement employees in our county, particularly in rural communities. Will there be an increase in hiring, provided you can find anyone even willing to do the job?

The potential increase in cannabis farms, facilities and crime is of serious concern to the people of San Diego County.

Please consider your actions and votes very carefully.

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To whom it may concern, I'm requesting immediate administrative leave and a formal misconduct investigation into Assistant Director Rachael Borrelli (Department of Animal Services) following the publication of on-record audio in which she states: "In Carlsbad, they don't euthanize anything, even if the dog fucking bit a kid... That's why I was like, 'Euthanize the dog.' I'm so sick of us keeping shit dogs that aren't going to get adopted. That's why we're overcrowded. Call me heartless, but I'm also realistic." (Source: KPBS report with audio - <https://tinyurl.com/26nfmw6u>) This is a senior official normalising euthanasia as a convenience strategy and demeaning animals and adopters. It flatly conflicts with the County's stated "no healthy or treatable animal is euthanized" standard and undermines public trust, partner rescues, and volunteer recruitment. If this is how leadership speaks in private, policy and case decisions are at risk of being biased in practice. I'm asking for the following actions: 1. Place Ms. Borrelli on paid administrative leave pending findings. 2. Direct the Office of Ethics & Compliance to investigate her conduct, decision-making influence on euthanasia outcomes, and any retaliatory culture toward staff/rescues who objected. 3. Publish, within 30 days, a transparent euthanasia dashboard (species, reason codes, behavior notes, medical status, length of stay, outcome reviewer) for the past 24 months. 4. Commission an external policy review (independent animal-welfare auditor) of DAS triage, behavior evaluations, and "bite" case protocols to ensure they align with best practice and are not being short-circuited by capacity pressure. 5. Agendize this item at the next Board meeting, with public comment and a staff report on corrective actions. 6. If the quote and context are confirmed, remove Ms. Borrelli from leadership and recruit a replacement who demonstrably supports evidence-based sheltering and public safety without resorting to "convenience kill" rhetoric. You don't fix overcrowding by killing your way to comfort. You fix it with competent leadership, data-driven protocols, and community partnership. Replace the problem, or the public will assume the problem is policy. If Delaware, Rhode Island, Vermont, and New Hampshire can achieve and maintain No-Kill status, San Diego County shouldn't have a problem achieving it too. Sincerely,
