Hi Supervisors,

I'm glad you ended the mPOX emergency, even if it was out of public view. At 448 total cases, 13 hospitalizations, no deaths, there never should have been one. And reporting was like the ad biz. Sensational headlines, but the charts couldn't tell monkeypox from the 30-odd types of orthopoxvirus. Hope this is a lesson learned.

As of 11/3, the County's COVID dashboard shows 204 cases of COVID, 127 vaxxed and 77 unvaxxed; 14 hospitalizations, 12 vaxxed and 2 unvaxxed; and the final figures for September are 22 deaths vaxxed, 7 unvaxxed, a 3.3 to 1 ratio!

(a 1.65 to 1 ratio for cases, a 6 to 1 ratio for hospitalizations)

It's becoming clear that the current tests for COVID pick up both active cases and cases that happened months ago but the mRNA remains in the body. Therefore, any testing you authorize needs to be for active disease only!

Meanwhile, we're playing 'scrabble-soup whack-a-mole' with all the Omicron variants - a lot about how sneaky they are but reports I've seen say the latest variant XBB is not actually more serious. I want numbers, real believable statistics. Meanwhile, there is plenty of evidence that the mRNA VAX is as harmful as the disease itself.

I sent you evidence. Mike Borello sent you reams of evidence. If you're on your job, you would have read it and responded.

Time to cancel the old emergency declaration, and issue a new one with the current facts - that something is wrong with the vax and an antidote must be developed. This is the emergency that the political-medical establishment created.
