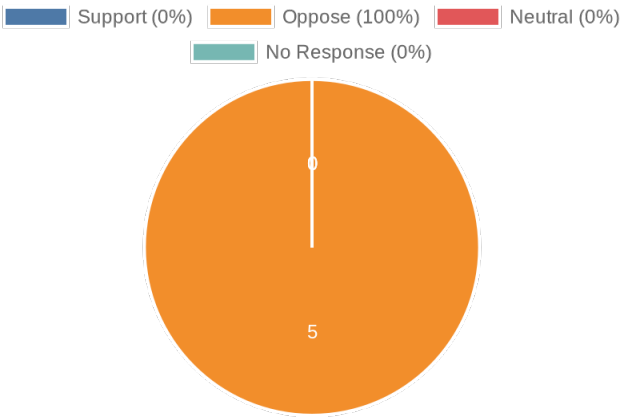

Overall Sentiment



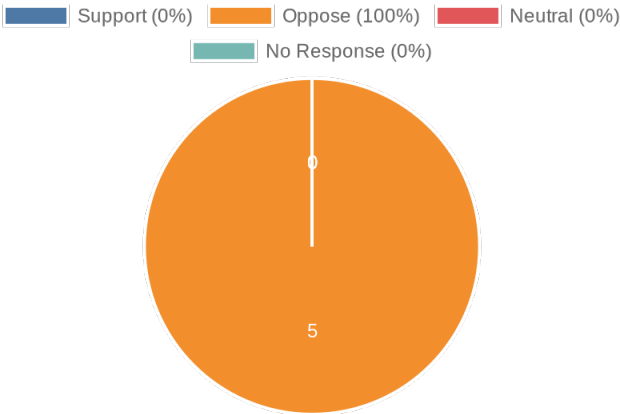

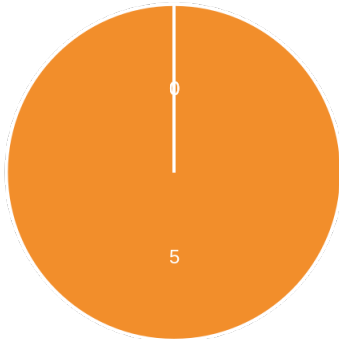
Overall Sentiment

This Board should not grant standalone status to Behavioral Health Services (BHS) while the department is mired in uninvestigated corruption and a total breakdown of professional conduct. I grew up watching the leadership of Alfredo Aguirre, Henry Tarke, and Yael Koenig. I know exactly what integrity and advocacy look like in this department. The current conduct of BHS employees—specifically the 'Inci Conflict' involving Deputy Administrator Joseph M. Inci and the retaliatory housing I am currently enduring—is a disgrace that these leaders would never have accepted. Mr. Inci allegedly operates as a private landlord for the very residents his department oversees

I formally oppose Item #8. This Board should not grant standalone status to Behavioral Health Services (BHS)

while it operates a corruption nexus with its primary contractors. Evidence has been submitted to the Clerk and the DOJ regarding BHS Deputy Administrator Joseph M. Inci, who allegedly serves as a private landlord for the very residents his department is tasked with protecting. This is a blatant conflict of interest and a violation of public trust. I am a whistleblower with autism who was placed in retaliatory housing—a facility with collapsing floors and roach infestations—as punishment for exposing this 'self-dealing.' The BHS Director has had actual knowledge of this neglect and failed to intervene. Following the \$4 million Amy J. Knox scandal, it is clear BHS lacks the internal oversight necessary for departmental independence. I demand this item be postponed pending a full ethics audit and a referral to the Civil Grand Jury.

This is a government ploy to set up a new department, perhaps to rehire old friends, and not worth the extra cost. It may also end up denying full support to the people who need Medical and CalFresh. I urge you to reject this scheme.

Looking at the workforce, it is clear that all of these changes require new expensive hires.

Not sure why the August 2025 proposal links changes to Medicaid and nutritional programs with the realignment of the Behavioral Health System (BHS) into a standalone department. BHS uses many of the same resources as a hospital. BHS and other medical services belong in the same organization.

The title stresses transformation, but Recommendation b(1) says that Behavioral Health Services should be its own department including adjustments to governance, organizational alignment, staffing, and resource deployment. It would seem that this would entail the use of more resources which could have been used to support Medicare and Nutritional Assistance cuts.
