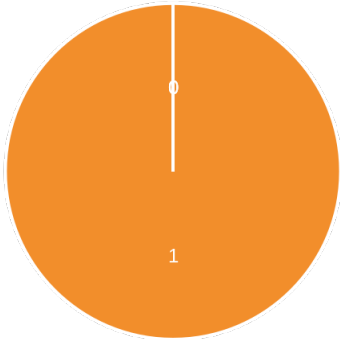
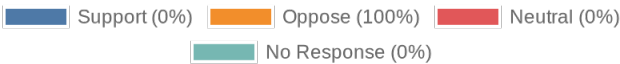

Overall Sentiment

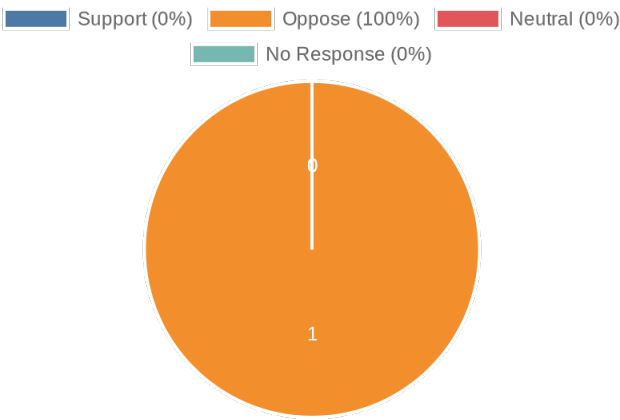

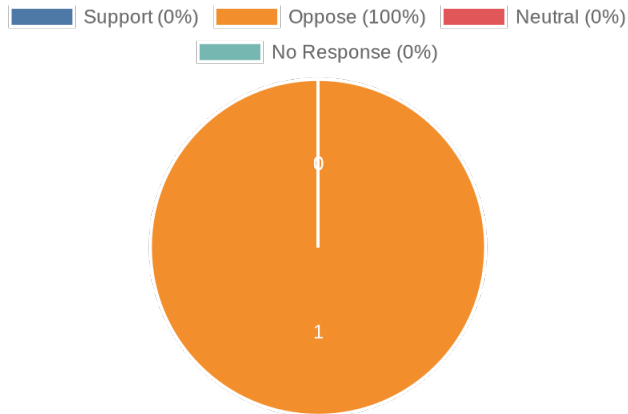
