

SUMMARY OF PROPOSED ORDINANCE

Notice is Hereby Given that the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Diego will consider for adoption:

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE SAN DIEGO COUNTY CODE OF REGULATORY ORDINANCES, TITLE 2, DIVISION 2, CHAPTER 4, RELATING TO SETTING INITIAL RATES FOR THE CANNABIS BUSINESS TAX

The ordinance will set the initial rates of the voter approved Cannabis Business Tax (Measure A of the November 8, 2022, General Election in San Diego County). The San Diego County Code of Regulatory Ordinances, as approved by the voters, sets the maximum allowable tax rates at 6% of gross receipts for Retail, 4% for Manufacturer, 3% for Distributor, 2% for Testing, and \$10/sf or 3% of gross receipts for Cultivation. The initial rates of the tax may be set by the Board of Supervisors when the ordinance is presented for the first reading on January 24, 2023.

Public testimony will be received by the Board of Supervisors on January 24, 2023. Interested persons are encouraged to review the text of the proposed ordinance in detail. A copy of the full text of the ordinance is available online at <http://www.sandiegocob.com>.
