In Fiscal Year 2026-27 the proposed annual assessment will be maintained at the FY 2025-26 rate of \$2.00, without an increase. The Board intends that such assessments shall be collected on the tax roll for Fiscal Year 2026-27 in the same manner and at the same time as ordinary County ad valorem property taxes are collected. The assessments, as confirmed, shall appear as a separate item on the tax bill.
