We would like to start by thanking the San Diego County Board of Supervisors for generously investing in the San Diego Regional Epicentre.

We would also like to acknowledge the staff who have engaged respectfully with us for the last 18 months or so and who have literally addressed all of our concerns in regard to the covenants and conditions of the project.

With huge shout outs to Brandon Schroeder, Riley DeWitt-Rickards, and Alyssa Way who have attended every meeting, patiently listening and taking notes.

We share the County's vision of making the Epicentre the hub of the community.

As concerned citizens who live in the community and having experienced the failure of the previous Epicentre we want to be able to pass the torch on to future generations, knowing we have done our due diligence in assuring that the Epicentre and the surrounding park are protected and preserved for recreational and cultural purposes for many years to come.

Therefore we would like to reinforce our understanding that the following actions have been or are being taken.

1. The corrections of confusing zoning records to be zoned to open park space, in order to prevent future encroachment by commercial or residential development.

2. The removal of the CDBG in order to open up programming options.
3. That the Epicentre be a community center for all ages.
4. That the property be environmentally safe.

What will happen to the property?

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







Taking these actions will also:

- a. **Increase Park Space:** Add approximately an acre and a quarter to the city's much-needed park space.
- b. **Protect Against Disputes:** Safeguard the park against potential disputes related to ingress, egress, and parking, as access to the Epicentre by vehicle requires entry through park property, and the Epicentre and the park share the same parking lot.
- c. **Prevent Negative Usage:** Ensure the property is not used in ways that may negatively affect the social and physical environment of the park.
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- e. **Optimize Coordination:** Enhance the ability to coordinate overflow activities from the overstretched recreation center.

We firmly believe that the City of San Diego should not be relieved of its obligation to maintain and preserve the Epicentre, an asset integral to the Mira Mesa Community Park.

To allow flexible programming that serves all ages and focuses on recreational activities, we further urge City Officials to **remove the CDBG encumbrance on the Epicentre.**

Let us protect the future of Mira Mesa. Our community cannot be overlooked anymore.
