It is unfortunate that the case summaries are not readily available, and that the Board Letter is typed manually and not readily copied from the Board Letter.

I see a few environmental cases – probably the result of favoring developers who skirt zoning ordinances (and incidentally threatening the environment) such as the one in Bonita.

But I know you have about 150 Polinsky Center cases to discuss – take a bold step and maybe people will be more willing to settle if you just shut it down.

More and more cases and time and money down the drain. I would suggest reviewing all of the cases against the County and seeing which ones are impractical and costly to pursue – you will need all the money you can save to put in reserve funds.

And let me add that no-one should be calling other people derogatory names or personal insults, whether you or us – and no-one should be violating the law.
