Not sure why we only get a pie chart and not a full report. To call an annotated pie chart an itemized report as called for in Penal Code 4025e is a bit of a stretch. It would also be nice to know if any of these funds in fact augment County expenses. Maybe the County needs to provide more?

The Board Letter also says "Funds are expended primarily for educational, vocational, and behavioral training that supports" the releasees' re-integration into society. We should know how much is spent on each category.

Congratulations to the Sheriff on spending only 3.7% on Ops and Supports, but I think the report should be redone.
