





Approximately 2,000 residents and only 220 acres, also surrounded by National City. Since National City also provides many of their utilities, it may be less expensive to get services from the City, and therefore I would recommend that you consider negotiating for a special Lincoln Acres representative on the City Planning Commission.

However, setting up a CSG for just 2,000 people would involve cost for relatively little benefit. And I see nothing in the Board Letter about anyone actually being disenfranchised.
