These ordinances update various sections in the San Diego County Administrative Code and San Diego County Code of Regulatory Ordinances to clarify language and update information to comply with current statutes and operations. Said proposed ordinances will be presented to the Board of Supervisors for the first reading on November 15, 2022, at which time public testimony will be received.
