

ORDINANCE NO. 10875 (N.S.)

**AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ARTICLE XXI OF THE SAN DIEGO COUNTY
ADMINISTRATIVE CODE, RELATING TO INTERGOVERNMENTAL REPRESENTATION**

The Board of Supervisors of the County of San Diego ordains as follows:

Section 1. The Board of Supervisors finds and determines that the purpose of this ordinance is to repeal administrative ordinances relating to intergovernmental representation.

Section 2. Article XXI, Intergovernmental Representation, of the San Diego County Administrative Code is hereby repealed in its entirety.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days after its passage, and before the expiration of fifteen days after its passage, a summary hereof shall be published once with the names of the members of this Board voting for and against it in a newspaper of general circulation published in the County of San Diego.


