Please see the attached correspondence and include in item #35 on the item's letters attachments online from Shane Harris regarding Agenda Item #35 involving the proposed wind-down of San Pasqual Academy and the request for a 90-day continuance of any closure-related actions pertaining to the campus.

As referenced in the attached letter, our office has been informed by County staff that although Item #35 is currently listed on Tuesday's Board agenda, the matter is expected to be heard as a time-certain item during Wednesday morning's Board of Supervisors Land Use session.

**The attached letter outlines significant concerns surrounding:**

- **The shift from what stakeholders understood to be an informational 180-day listening session update into proposed closure-related actions**
- **The lack of broad public outreach and stakeholder engagement**
- **Concerns raised by current and former foster youth connected to the Academy**
- **The absence of a clear transition or continuity plan for the Academy's long standing Grandparent Program and senior volunteers**
- **Recommendations for a 90-day continuance and expanded stakeholder process before any permanent decisions are considered**
