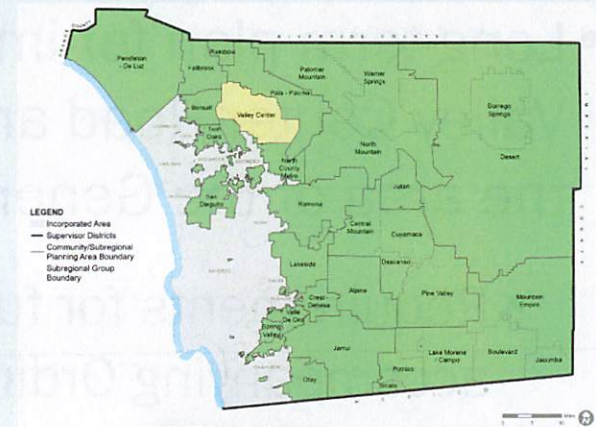

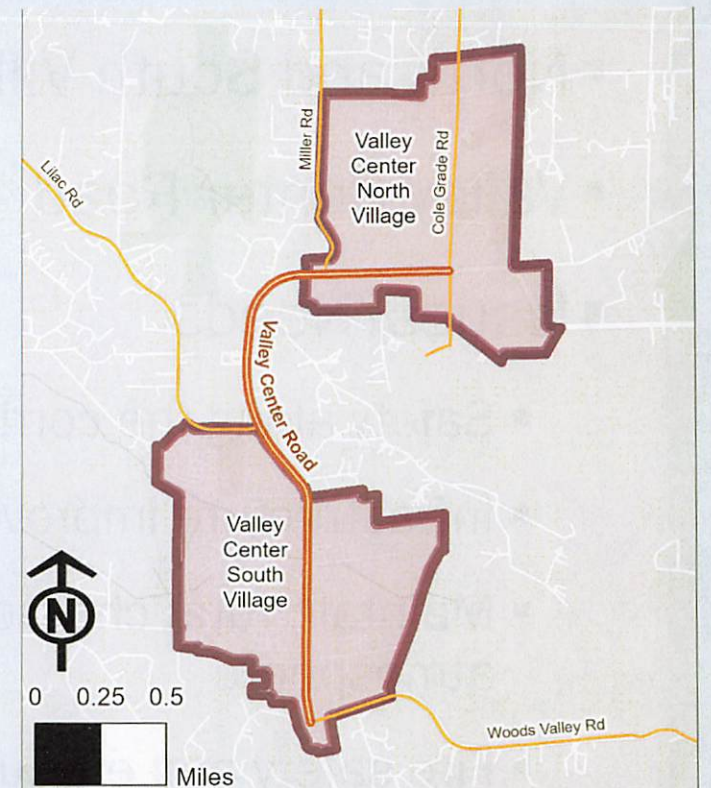
Valley Center and Project Need

- North and South Villages
- Valley Center Road
- Issues/Needs
 - Safety along the corridor
 - Infrastructure improvements
 - Maintain rural character and develop village atmosphere
 - Fire safety and evacuation focus



Corridor Concept Plan Scope

- Long-term plan for improvements to Valley Center Road and right-of-way in the area of the General Plan Villages
 - Requirements for future projects with accompanying Ordinance
- Woods Valley Road intersection to Cole Grade Road intersection



VCRCCP Geographic Scope

Public Engagement & Common Input



- 78 public engagement/stakeholder meetings in varied formats
- Common Input (wide range of viewpoints)
 - Traffic calming needed to reduce speeding and collisions
 - Challenging left turns from stop-controlled side streets; illegal maneuvers in center turn lane
 - Emergency response & evacuation focus
 - Accommodate large vehicles & trailers

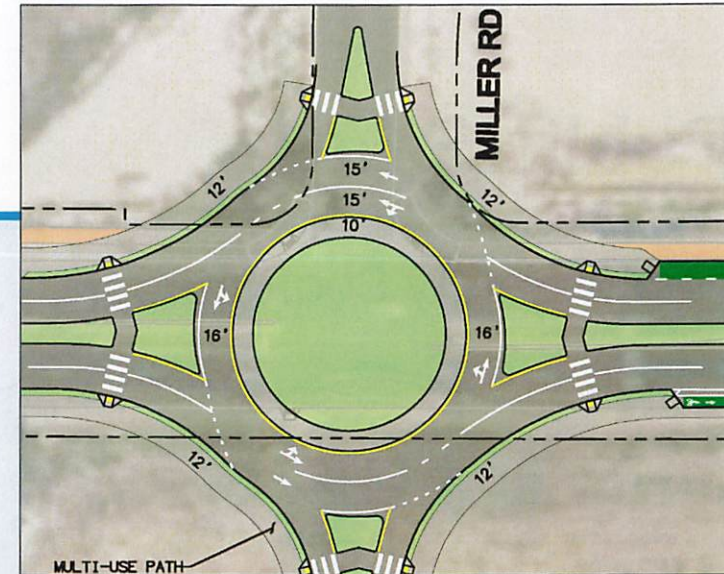

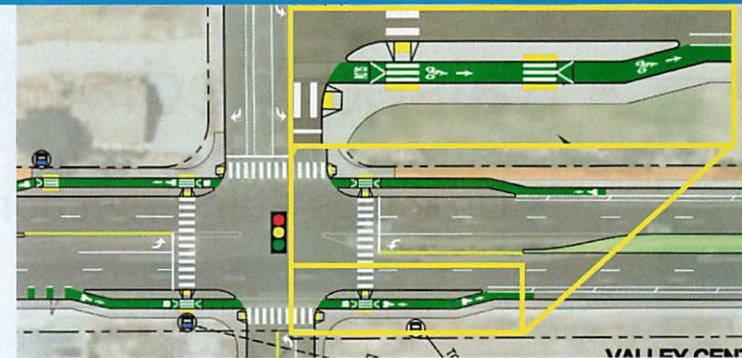
Intersection Controls

- Roundabout at Miller Road
 - Traffic Calming
 - Improve Traffic Flow
- Signals at Old Road & Sunday Drive
 - Old Road at End of Curve
 - Ingress/Egress for New Development

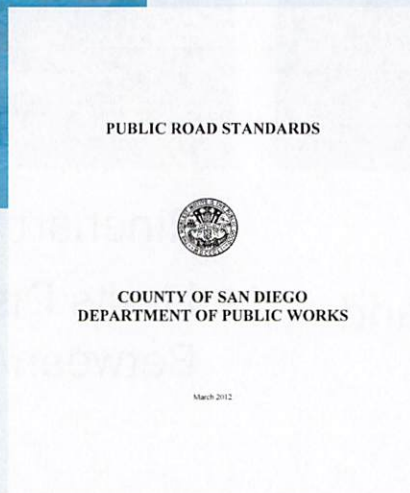
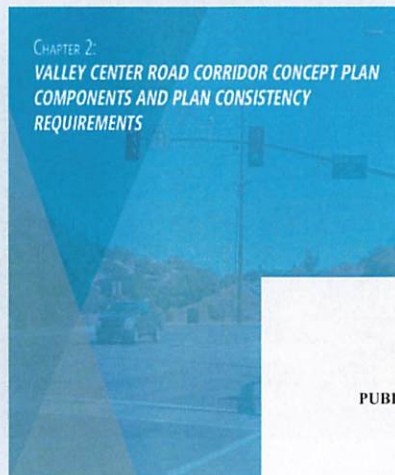

Ordinance & Implementation



- VCRCCP into Regulatory Code by Ordinance
- Supplements & Supersedes Public Road Standards
- New Requirements for Future Public and Private Projects
- Incremental Implementation
 - Grant Funded County Projects
 - Private Development Project Conditioning

Community Planning Group Recommendation

- After reviewing all options at their February 12, 2024, meeting, the Valley Center CPG considered a compromise motion to include one roundabout in the Plan
- The CPG voted to recommend 2023 VCRCCP Option A with one revision, to remove the roundabout at the Woods Valley Road intersection in that Option
- The VCRCCP under consideration today was prepared in accordance with this recommendation

Staff Recommendations

- On February 26, 2025:
 - Find that the proposed project complies with the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) and State and County CEQA Guidelines
 - Approve the introduction of the Ordinance (first reading) to integrate the VCRCCP into the County Code of Regulatory Ordinances
- If, on February 26, 2025, the Board takes the action recommended, then on March 12, 2025:
 - Adopt the VCRCCP
 - Adopt the Ordinance
