The Board of Supervisors met in closed session on March 3, 2026, from 4:12 p.m. to 4:43 p.m. All Board members were present. All items on the closed session agenda were heard except Item 18A. The Board took the following reportable actions:

On Items 18B and SA01 A, Vera Skop, et al. v. La Mesa Spring Valley School District, et al., by a vote of 5-0, the Board authorized the San Diego County Sanitation District to be defended by County Counsel.

On Item 18D, Sierra Club v. County of San Diego, by a vote of 5-0, the Board authorized County Counsel to appeal the Superior Court's decision allowing Sierra Club's challenge to the Harmony Grove Village South development project to go forward.

On Item 18F, by a vote of 4-1, with Supervisor Desmond voting “No,” the Board authorized County Counsel to initiate litigation. Particulars about the litigation will be disclosed to any person upon inquiry, after litigation has formally commenced.
