

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING  
(INCLUDING SUMMARY OF ORDINANCE)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Diego will conduct a public hearing on a proposed ordinance that adds a new Section to Article XXV, of the San Diego County Code of Administrative Ordinances relating to adopting a publicly released, written military equipment use policy, which must address a number of specific topics, including the type, quantity, capabilities, purposes, and authorized uses of each type of equipment, the fiscal impact of their acquisition and use, the legal and procedural rules that govern their use, the training required by any officer allowed to use them, the mechanisms in place to ensure policy compliance, and the procedures by which the public may register complaints. Said proposed ordinance will be presented to the Board of Supervisors for public testimony on April 5, 2022 and adoption on April 26, 2022.

The Board meets at 9:00 a.m., in Room 310, County Administration Center, 1600 Pacific Highway, San Diego, California.
